

SMGA TOURNAMENTS

Open to all members of the Southbridge Men's Golf Association (SMGA) whose current annual dues are paid.

The SMGA conducts tournaments throughout the year scheduled to provide events that do not conflict with Southbridge Club events and to provide opportunities during months when there are no Club events.

One Day Tournaments Schedule: Typically, one day tournaments are conducted during the months of January, February, March, April, June, August, October and December.

Formats: Various formats are employed. Most formats are for individual competition. Typically, some events are conducted as two-man team events and one as a team event with half the entries on each team in a match play format.

Tees and scoring vary for individual events.

Entry Fees: Currently, the Entry Fee for one day events is \$25. All events include lunch and prizes based on the number of entries. Prizes are awarded as Credit Book to members' accounts and gift certificates for those who are not members of Southbridge Golf Club. The costs of these events are subsidized by dues from SMGA membership.

There is no entry fee for the December event for those who have paid their dues for the coming year.

SMGA CHAMPIONSHIP

Schedule:

The SMGA Championship is a two-day tournament beginning on the first or second Saturday of July each year.

Format:

This is a stroke play event. Gross and Net Champions are recognized in multiple divisions.

Typically, Gross Champions will be determined for Men, Seniors, Super Seniors, and Legends.

All SMGA members may compete in the Men's Division from the SMGA Tees. SMGA members who are at least 50 years of age may compete in the Senior's Division from the White Tees. SMGA members who are at least 65 years of age may compete in the Super Senior's Division from the Green Tees. SMGA members who are at least 75 years of age may compete in the Legends Division from the Silver Tees. If there are not enough entrants in the Legends Division, Players 75 and up may play the Silver Tees and compete in the Super Senior Division. Silver Tees participants in the Super Senior Division are not eligible for Gross Score prizes.

Ties for Gross Champion will be resolved in a three-hole playoff. Ties for Net Champion will be shared.

Entry Fee: The entry fee for the SMGA Championship is \$40. On Saturday evening, each participant and a guest may attend a dinner at the Southbridge clubhouse. Lunch is provided for all participants at the conclusion of play on Sunday. The cost of the dinner and lunches is paid by the SMGA.
